2021 HOA Annual Meeting Summary

We gathered at Bemis Library on December 9th to review 2021 accomplishments, 2022

goals, and yearly budget. We also elected a new president replacing Brad Shelly who is stepping down after many years of service. Other highlights:

- The 2022 budget was reviewed. In sync with the CPI for 2021, the monthly HOA fee will increase by 6% to \$320/month.
- Michelle Carter was elected to replace current president Brad Shelly. Brad will move into an At Large Board position.
- The VAL HOA had many 2021 accomplishments which included:
 - Significant safety improvements to interior & exterior sidewalks
 - The creation of the Hospitality Committee increasing community connections and fun
 - A new snow removal contractor reducing cost to the association
 - Movie Night, Little Lending Library, and many landscape enhancements!

2022 goals include additional exterior sidewalk repairs and the development of a proposed timeline to repaint complex buildings.

2021 Landscape Committee Report

In 2021 the landscape committee planted more trees and replaced some of the plants at the complex entrances. Several residents have made improvements to the areas outside of their patio fences which is serving to improve the overall appearance of our properties. Thank you! We tore out the old garden in front of properties 1417-1419 and planted a new perennial garden in its place.

New shrubs were planted in front of the 1415 property and on the west side entrance alongside Lake Ave., new grass. Danny Carter treated several Ash trees for emerald ash borer.

Our HOA is experiencing large water bills and our committee has been discussing this complicated issue. One generous homeowner requested to cap the sprinklers west of the Datura mailboxes and install rock there at no cost to the HOA. After much discussion and consideration, we decided not to approve this request because the trees in that area will suffer without receiving water from the sprinklers.

This past year there were some areas that were overwatered, and others underwatered. A very important goal for the new year is to work with the new sprinkler maintenance person to get the sprinkler system

working correctly and more efficiently. Our hopes are that the water bills can be significantly reduced in this way.

Additional goals for 2022: we would like to see some additional shrubs planted along Datura Street.

Thank you to all the members of our VAL community who helped with these projects.



HOA Dues Increasing
